

BEVERLEY DISTRICTS MOTORCYCLE CLUB

2009 GENERAL RULES

- BDMC is proudly MWA affiliated and our Committee and Members are required to conduct themselves according to MWA/MA rules and policies.
- The Beverley Districts motorcycle club caters for 2 wheel motocross bikes only.
- All riders/officials are to ensure they are familiar with all Club rules and check that a valid/current MWA permit is in place and on display BEFORE signing on and riding. Sign on books for riders and officials must be properly completed. A detailed receipt is to be written with the prescribed track fee included and paid.
- Juniors are not to ride with seniors at any time.
- We do not cater to quadbike riders as of 11/05/2009 and they are not to be ridden on the track or any BDMC land.
- A minimum of 3 flag points must be covered before practice commences (numbers permitting). Flag point 6 (rear tabletop), 11 (camels hump), and 19 (finish tabletop) are priority.
- For both competitive and non-competitive Club riding days, a 6 rider minimum is required for all classes. Insufficient numbers will result in cancellation of that class for that day (unless over-ruled by the Steward on the day). Where allowed, classes will be combined.
- All members/riders must have their current club membership and MWA licenses on them at all times. No one is allowed to ride unless they can produce current membership cards and license cards or papers.
- All protective gear must be worn at all times in accordance with the Manual of Motorcycle Sport. Riding attire e.g.: Boots, riding pants, long sleeve shirt (sleeves down), jumper/jacket, gloves, goggles, and an approved helmet. Juniors must have armour.
- Riding a motorcycle anywhere other than the circuit in an anti clockwise direction is prohibited. Entry is only through the pit starting docks, and exit through the pit return. Riding in the pit area, car park or bushlands is not allowed at any time.
- The first lap shall be slow to enable the rider to evaluate the condition and any hazards that may exist.
- Damage to the track or club property must be reported to the president or vice president immediately (see below list for phone contact details)
- Any injuries requiring medical attention must be reported to MWA and the Club President or Vice President immediately (see below list for phone contact details).

- Any member allowing a non member to ride a motorcycle anywhere on club grounds will have their membership terminated. NO EXCEPTIONS
- Practice is for daylight hours only. Practice must be shared (equal time) between classes, unless organised coaching sessions are being held.
- Practicing riders must be accompanied by a current MWA level 1 (or above) official who will actively supervise all riding. All activity at BDMCC must be carried out in accordance with MWA/MA rules at all times.
- Each financial member (or guardian/parent in the case of members under 18 years of age) may apply for a numbered track gate key for their own personal use. Key holders must not loan their keys to anyone else, and are responsible for any property damage or loss while they are on the Club property. ***The front gate is to be kept locked at all times*** to prevent unauthorised people entering the property.
- To be considered for a club gate key, a signed KEY HOLDER APPLICATION form and \$50 deposit (fully refunded upon key return before December 1st 2009) is to be submitted to the Beverley Districts Motorcycle Club.
- The key remains the property of the Beverley Districts Motorcycle Club and must be returned upon request. All keys are to be handed back to BDMCC by December 1st 2009 in order to allow for deposits to be refunded before the end of the year.
- Camping on grounds is only permitted with consent from the club committee panel. General fire bans apply. All rubbish is to be removed, NOT left in the onsite bins.
- Unauthorised entry is strictly forbidden.
- The club will be closed from time to time. Members will be informed via the beverleymx.com web page, phone call, letter, or a Closed sign on the front gate.

ANY BREACH OF BDMCC RULES MAY RESULT IN A FINE, MEMBERSHIP TERMINATION AND/OR MWA/MA LICENSE SUSPENSION.

****In an Emergency call 000 or 112 for Police, Fire or Ambulance assistance. Your location is Ulinga Park on Nicholas Street in Beverley. Use the rubbish tip as a point of reference. Remember to unlock the front gate for emergency service vehicles. ****
